

**REQUEST FOR QUOTATION FOR PROCUREMENT FOR THE
ASSESSMENT/INSPECTION OF THE CHANCERY AND THE
OFFICIAL RESIDENCE AT THE PHILIPPINE EMBASSY IN CANBERRA
FOR THE SUSPECTED PRESENCE OF ASBESTOS**

1. The Philippine Embassy in Canberra, through the authorized appropriations under the General Appropriations Act, intends to apply the sum of **Ten Thousand Nine Hundred Forty-Five Australian Dollars (A\$10,945.00) only**, being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the procurement for the assessment/ inspection of the Chancery and the Official Residence at the Philippine Embassy in Canberra for the suspected presence of asbestos.

<p>Asbestos Materials Survey and Report</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● On-site inspection by a qualified Occupational Hygienist to identify the presence, location, condition and risk of suspected asbestos building materials within the nominated areas; ● Assess the current condition of the identified areas, if any; ● Review any publicly available or received site documentation relevant to the buildings and structures on site; ● Collect samples for analysis of asbestos as required, and take photographic records; ● Complete works in accordance with all relevant regulatory guidelines and codes of practice, in a timely, safe, and efficient manner; ● Provide with information pertinent to the asbestos building materials identification, risk; ● Provide risk and recommendations on the wayforward in the hazardous materials survey; ● Provide a comprehensive report; and ● Exercise caution by collecting representative and small samples from non-visible spots and making safe sampling points immediately following sampling. <p style="text-align: center;"><i>All quotes must be inclusive of GST, and documentation, delivery cost, if any</i></p>	<p>A\$10,945.00</p>
