

**REQUEST FOR QUOTATION  
FOR THE PROCUREMENT FOR THE SUPPLY AND INSTALLATION OF  
CLOSED-CIRCUIT TELEVISION (CCTV) SYSTEM AT THE  
PHILIPPINE EMBASSY IN CANBERRA**

1. The Philippine Embassy in Canberra, through the authorized appropriations under the General Appropriations Act, intends to apply the amount of Eleven Thousand and Twenty Australian Dollars (A\$11,020.00) only, being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) for the procurement for the supply and installation of Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) system at the Philippine Embassy in Canberra.
2. The Philippine Embassy in Canberra Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) now invites submission of quotations for the aforementioned procurement, described as follows:

<p><b>Supply, delivery, installation, testing, and commissioning of a CCTV Surveillance System, including, but not limited to, the following general requirements:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Network Video Recorder (NVR) with a minimum eight (8)-channel capacity</li> <li>● Minimum of three (3) AI-enabled CCTV cameras with panoramic/180-degree viewing capability, integrated alarm/light functions, and two-way audio communication</li> <li>● Minimum 4TB surveillance-grade storage device</li> <li>● Wireless point-to-point communication system, including master and slave radio devices</li> <li>● Power-over-Ethernet (PoE) switches and associated networking equipment</li> <li>● Supply and installation of Cat6 cabling and related accessories necessary for system operation</li> <li>● Mounting poles/brackets and weather-protected enclosures for outdoor equipment</li> <li>● Mobile application accessibility and remote viewing capability</li> <li>● Complete system configuration, integration, testing, and demonstration upon completion</li> <li>● Minimum six (6) months of technical support after installation</li> <li>● Minimum three (3)-year warranty covering equipment and installation workmanship</li> <li>● Provision and installation of all necessary electrical/power connections and related works required for the complete operation of outdoor poles, cameras, radios, switches, and associated equipment.</li> </ul> <p><i>All quotations shall be inclusive of GST, supply, delivery, installation, labor, electrical works, configuration, testing, commissioning, and all other incidental and necessary costs for the complete and operational installation of the CCTV system.</i></p>	<p>A\$ 11,020.00</p>
